

RULES – SCORING--TIMING

Please have your team and roster ready 15 minutes prior to start time
All teams will play at least 3 games on Saturday

2nd—3rd—4th grade games will use the small ball

· 2nd—3rd—4th grade will not be allowed to press or zone defense—no exceptions

2nd—3rd—4th grade will have 15 minute running halves—clock stops inside 2 minutes

FREE THROWS —when a player is awarded a free throw, he/she will have the free throw, and the free throw line will not be enforced. The shooter can move up to a comfortable spot, and the remaining players will line up on the lane for rebounding.

Clocks will continue to run with mercy rule in effect—12 points or more difference

Saturday games will not have overtime—games will end in a tie

If there is no 3-point line—no 3 point score

3 timeouts per game

5 minute grace period—unless arrangements made

No players—coaches --- at the scorers table during live balls.

No PARENTS or FANS at the scorers table during the game period.

These timers and scorers have a very difficult job, they do it well, and they do not need any unnecessary distractions.

No exceptions-- technicals will be given to coaches and players----fans and parents will be removed from gym.

And finally—remember “the officials are in control—they are all good, seasoned veterans” -- and without their help and time-these tourney's would not happen
